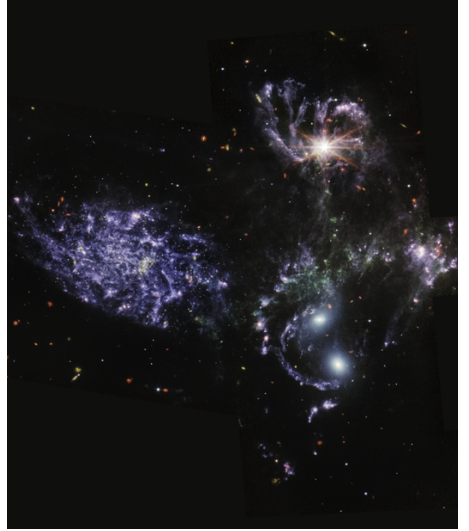
HOW:

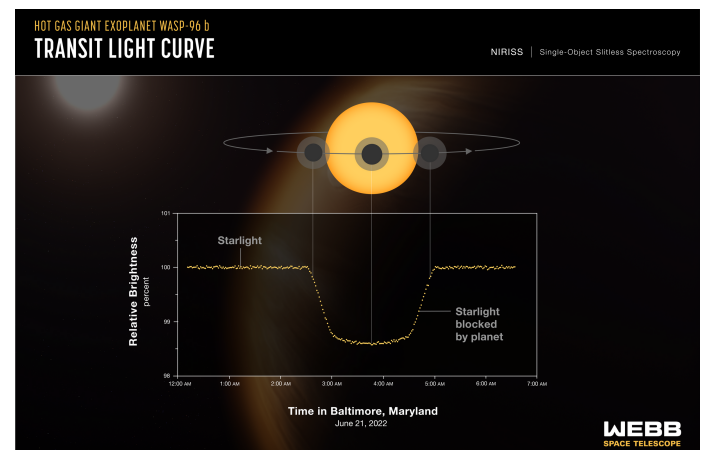
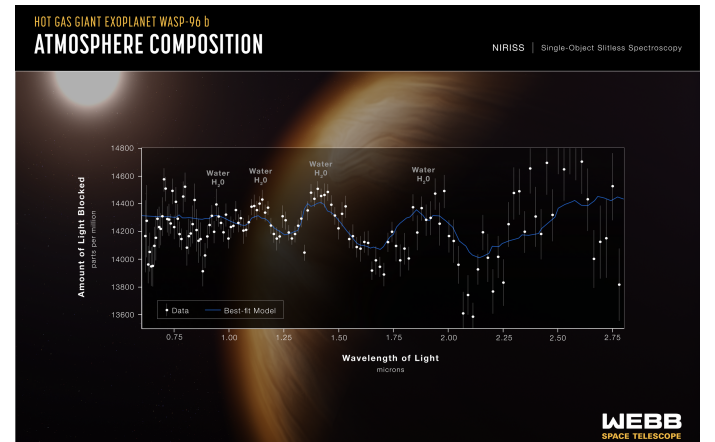
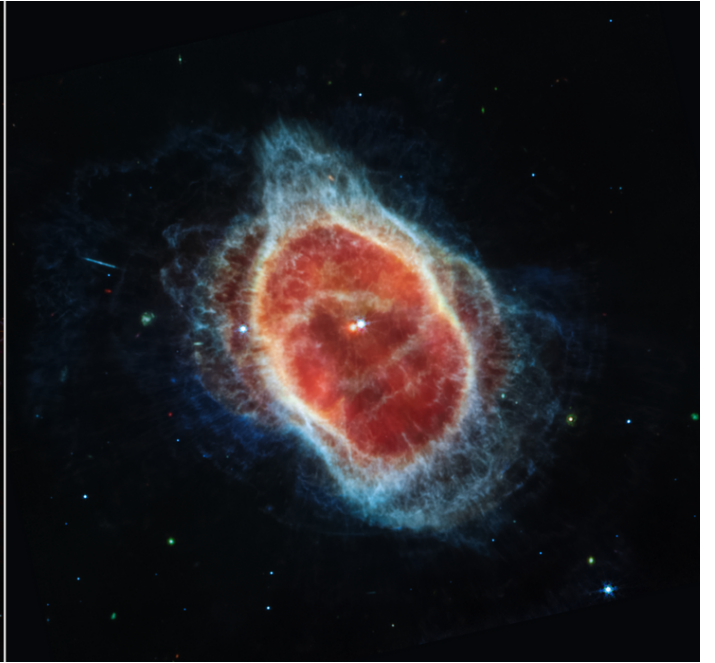
